Old Business

Flight line shade and station extension project

Steve Patterson stated that he has someone scheduled for tomorrow (Nov 13th) at the field to prepare the ground for installation of the new 12' X 50' flight line covering.

Electrical outlet stations will be added after the covering is installed. The number and layout of stations is to be determined.

Runway repair

Todd has three options for runway repair. All options are about \$2000 each.

The covering we last applied to the runway surface is called *Airport Sealing*.

New Business

Alternative monthly meeting site

Todd found out that Pellissippi State has space for meetings. He will contact them to verify the cost per meeting of a room for December, February, March, and April. By a majority vote, Todd may reserve a room if the cost is less than or equal to \$100 per meeting.

Repair of rope fence in parking area

It was agreed that the withering rope will not be replaced. Some expressed a desire to remove it for easier walking to the flight line. In either case, we will leave the posts as a visual guide for parking.

Field first aid equipment

We will check the first aid kits and add/replace needed items.

Steve Jones will investigate the possibility of obtaining a pre-owned AED for field use.
